

IOSH Level 3 NVQ Certificate in Occupational Health and Safety (NON-SWAP)

This qualification is for new and aspiring occupational safety and health (OSH) professionals in a variety of sectors. It provides the knowledge and skills you need at the start of your career. It's also suitable if you already have a role with some responsibility for OSH and want to build your knowledge. You may be working as a supervisor, manager, team leader or preparing to work at this level.

The purpose of this qualification is to equip learners with the knowledge and understanding to progress into a job role in health and safety. It is generic and therefore suitable for those wishing to work in health and safety positions in a variety of sectors.

Entry criteria

Good written and spoken English skills are required. The minimum English Language skills equivalent required are:

- *B1 level qualification (Home Office's list of recognised English tests)*
- *Functional Skills Level E3-L1 in English and maths*

Students will complete an English, Maths and Digital Skills initial assessment as part of the enrolment and registration process to assess suitability for the programme.

We will support students with any English, maths and Digital Skills needs as part of their programme. Available courses include Bridging the Gap programme and Functional Skills for those who would benefit from English, maths or Digital Skills training.
