Completion of the course leads to qualified status as a Domestic Energy Assessor (DEA). Paid roles are available on an employment and self-employment basis, providing flexibility and suitability for all lifestyles and career options.

Once qualified, registration with Government-approved UK Accreditation bodies will lead to immediate paid work opportunities.

Modules covered as part of pre-employment and technical skills training aspect include:

- Evaluating the Options for Introducing Energy Efficiency Measures to Older and Traditional Buildings
- Make Recommendations and Provide Advice on the Introduction of Energy Efficiency Measures to Older and Traditional Buildings
- Recognising the Age, Nature and Characteristics of Older and Traditional Buildings
- How to undertake energy assessments in a safe, effective and professional manner
- The preparation and undertaking of an energy assessment
- How to produce and explain an Energy Performance Certificate (EPC) relating to a domestic property

Entry criteria

Good written and spoken English skills are required. The minimum English Language skills equivalent required are:

- B1 level qualification (Home Office's list of recognised English tests)
- Functional Skills Level L1 in English and maths

Students will complete an English, Maths and Digital Skills initial assessment as part of the enrolment and registration process to assess suitability for the programme.

We will support students with any English, maths, and Digital Skills needs as part of their programme.

Course duration: 6 weeks / 4 weeks employment support

Course start dates: November 2025, January 2026, February 2026, March 2026

Attendance details	Days: Mondays and Wednesdays - e-Learning (self-study) / exams Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays - Classroom Homework and self-study: There are 6-8 days of self-study throughout the course, including exam prep and revision. Self-study is ESSENTIAL.
Assessment/exam arrangements	The programme is assessed via multiple assessment methods: • The Energy Efficiency qualification is assessed via an online, multiple-choice exam. • The Domestic Energy Assessment qualification is assessed via online multiple-choice tests, practical tasks (i.e. property surveys) and a portfolio of evidence • The Certificate in Self-Employment is assessed via online unit tests and set assignments.
